

# PROGRAMMING FEE FY22

Affiliated students are assessed the Fraternity and Sorority Life Programming Fee each semester. The fee supplements the funds that the University of Iowa already dedicates towards the members of sorority and fraternity life. FSL will be using these funds towards the following: Educational programs, Leadership development opportunities, Prevention and wellness programming, and Staff support from the Office of Sorority and Fraternity Life.

The Programming Fee is charged to individual students' U-Bill accounts based on sorority and fraternity membership.. The following outlines for what programming fees are used. Please note these percentages are rounded for the purposes of this document.

### Salary and Fringe – 66%

Salary & Fringe portion of the Programming Fee Budget includes salaries for 3 full-time employees, as well as 2 summer stipended employees (Fraternity & Sorority Life student positions). These staff members advise Interfraternity Council, Multicultural Greek Council, National Pan-Hellenic Council, and Panhellenic Council. In addition to advisement, these staff members support the community in making connections across campus and in the community to provide students the best experience during their membership on campus.

### Leadership Training 3%

Fraternity & Sorority Life office provides leadership training for leaders who support our organizations. In FY22, there are plans to host trainings for the following leaders: council leaders, organization leaders, advisors, and house directors.

### Vendor Contracts – 13%

Currently, Fraternity & Sorority Life has shared contracts with Panhellenic and Interfraternity Councils for Phired Up. Phired Up provides our four councils with growth plans for recruitment and intake. In addition, Fraternity and Sorority Life partners with Iowa's IT department for app and web development of technology systems.

### Programmatic Expenses – 4%

Fraternity and Sorority Life provides multiple programs throughout the year to support students and leadership growth including Open House, Dining with the Deans and other miscellaneous programming.

### Fraternity and Sorority Life Awards – 1%

Every spring semester, Fraternity & Sorority Life celebrates the work our student leaders have done in the Fraternity & Sorority Life Community. This budget line item includes both the awards program, as well as the physical awards given to students who earn them.

### Marketing – 2%

Fraternity & Sorority Life works with Student Life Communications to market our programs throughout the year. The majority of this marketing expense is used to introduce our office to students looking to join the community.

### Council Support – 2%

There are two funds set aside to support our Multicultural Greek Council & National Pan-Hellenic Council. These funds will be used to support the priorities of these councils.

### Office Supplies 2%

Fraternity & Sorority Life uses the office supplies budget line to provide computers and technology licenses for full-time staff.

### Miscellaneous 5%

In addition to the line items outlined above, Fraternity & Sorority Life also provides financial support for Hawkeye Service Breaks sponsored team, Fraternity & Sorority Life , salaried staff's professional association fees, and Fraternity & Sorority Life leadership class
