

 - Ouestions to Start:
 - Article 14 section 3 about co-sponsored events: Does this mean that now co-sponsored events are now not allowed?
 - We wanted to delete with the exception portion of it
 - About the test files will there be anything with the university? Yes, if we find out we will have to take the next steps and report it to the university. As faculty the FSL staff has to report it because it is unethical. We are updating the bylaws to be in accordance with the bylaws.
 - Specificity of that bylaw: Be aware that because we are a university organization.
 - If an individual members has a chegg account, they will be held accountable not the chapter. This is for if a chapter if they are spending funds on it.
 - Ten business days for the invoices questions
 - Article 4 Section 4aa: there is a document online that is a form you fill out with FSL staff.
 - Article 9 section 2: Semester GPA change. Where did that number come from? The 2.75 was already there we just removed the cumulative gpa. You already need a cumulative gpa to be elected you just need the semester gpa to stay within your position.
 - Discussion: Is there anyone above a 2.9 to hold an exec position?
 - A couple people raised their hands
 - If we are on academic probation with our own chapter we are in trouble exec wise as well.
 - Article 14 section F: For overnight events- it is for alcohol

- If there is any sort of timeline for when you can be turned in for an event and when you get turned in for an event? There is no statute of limitations for the judicial manual. If we receive a report from a formal last fall, we have to do something about it. Once I receive an report, I have to send out a letter within 10 school days.
- An alcoholic social event...-- the factors must be the same
- Addendum article 1 section 12- removal of officer. 2 complaints of the same thing. You would
 get a complaint and then you would have a formal meeting to make an action plan. Two
 complaints about two different things- if it has been addressed and then happens again then
 that would be two strikes.
- Educational Change- I think that is a nice change. Updating the wording with the judicial hearing is also very nice.
 - Other chapters agree
- Liked that they change the PanHellenic exec board gpa. It makes the positions more accessible
