Responses:

- Extra resource within their chapter (ex: explaining the new Pilot Program)
- Delegate needs to be unbiased and a good communicator
- Characteristics: punctual, timely, etc.
- Member of an Executive Board
- Responsibility: time management, in good standing with your chapter, etc.

Pair with a PHC Council Officer

- WHAT DO YOU EXPECT FROM US AS A DELEGATE?

Responses:

- PHC expects delegates to be reliable communicators about information presented during meetings
- Delegates expect consistency in communication from PHC
- PHC expects delegates to be an advocate from your own organization to help and help communicate
- Delegates expect PHC Officers to be good leaders and eliminate redundant information

- PHC expects delegates to be knowledgeable and propose changes if chapter doesn't agree
- Transparency on all fronts
- "Being present" as a delegate and also expecting that from your chapter
