- Funding- in the past there has not been a significant relationship between IFC and PHC
- Groups must have an account with SOBO, if your chapter does not have one you can apply through PHC

- Question for delegates:
 - In your opinion, what does the future of FSL look like?
 - I hope it goes more towards professional development, skills and respect, and how to support each other in professional and social realms.
 - Health and wellness
 - More involvement amongst other sorority chapters. Showing up to other philanthropy events. And to be more involved with people who aren't involved in Greek life
 - Our community's statistics do not uphold what we say. If we want to move forward, we need to follow through with what you are saying
 - Being a rho gamma, I think we need to foster community. It can be hard to branch out and meet people in other chapters
 - The faults that are in our communities so that we can fix them. The stereotypes can't go away so that we can work to fix them. Examples: alcohol
 - Philanthropy and service are not the same. They are not meant to be a band aid for high risk behavior. Separate those conversations.
 - More important to tell them why we do things.
 - Prevent high risk partying. Can't stop them from drinking but educate them on how to drink smart.
 - What kind of impact do you want to have on the community?
 - I want to highlight the philanthropy and service. Most come from a privilege background so try to help others.
 - Share information with members about PHC, so that they know what's going on.
