 - **Description:** Flip the Script is a sexual assault resistance course for women, regardless of sexual orientation and inclusive of trans women, but focused on violence committed by men. The course is predicated on the understanding that it is

NEVER a victim's fault if they are sexually assaulted and reminds participants that there is no risk for sexual violence without the presence of a perpetrator.
