Reach out to the contact listed to request a program. Pick a date, time and location and advertise this to your chapter. Submit a pre-workshop form when all of your details are confirmed. You must submit this at minimum, ten days before the event. Confirm event with presenter 1 week before workshop. During Workshop Take attendance. You will need to submit a full roster in excel format and check off the members who were present. Post-Workshop Submit a post workshop form. You must submit it no more than ten days after the event. Important Reminders about Workshops

- During the Fall, you are expected to do 1 Violence Prevention training. You will need to submit a request form to notify the Violence Prevention Team that you are interested in having them present. This is an EXTRA step.
- Once 75% of your members have attended at least ONE workshop, you do not have to have
 - o This means you could have 1 workshop if 75% of your members attend
 - It is also alright if it takes you 5 workshops to hit that percentage requirement
- Many of the programs you national organizations require may also count for workshops. If you think it might, contact me and we can discuss this.
